## FAQs



### How must funds be used?

- ★ To be an eligible application, funding must be used in all three categories: part-time learning support staff, technology/curriculum, & training, based on the need of the school. While we would like to see the largest portion go to part-time learning support staff to aid students with learning disabilities, we ask that funding be distributed in all categories.

### Is funding guaranteed for two years?

- ★ St. Anthony's has not guaranteed funding for three schools for two years. All schools are required to reapply every year, including previously awarded schools.

### What is the reporting process?

- ★ Once all schools are awarded, we will supply those schools with the information regarding the reporting process. The reporting process will ask questions based on how this initiative aided both students with learning differences, as well as the school.

### Can I apply with another school?

- ★ Yes, we just ask that both schools' needs are individually expressed on the application and how this grant will benefit both schools' students and their financial need.

### Do we need a resource room/ St. Anthony's program to apply?

- ★ No, while some applicants may partner with St. Anthony's already, the goal of this initiative is to serve more students with learning disabilities, all while keeping them in their community Catholic school.

### Are the benefitting students considered St. Anthony's students?

- ★ No, the students will still be enrolled in their current school. The purpose of the grant is to give financial assistance to students not in St. Anthony School Programs, that have learning differences.
